## End of Course Examination

- 1) Label (from memory) the following on a map of the world: All continents, Big Bear Lake, Washington D.C., California, New York, The United States, Canada, Mexico, Cuba, France, Germany, Russia, Japan, China, India, all oceans, the northern and southern hemispheres, the equator, the Sierra Nevada Mountains, the Appalachian Mountains, the Mississippi River, The Rocky Mountains, the Gulf of Mexico, the “Pacific Rim”.
- 2) With the use of a map, use latitude and longitude to describe the approximate midpoint of Florida, Texas, Hawaii, England, Egypt, and Iceland
- 3) Write and/or diagram a description of the water cycle
- 4) Explain in writing the relationship between latitude and temperature
- 5) Write and/or diagram the movements of the sun, moon, and planets in our solar system
- 6) Explain and diagram the movement of the earth and sun during the four seasons
- 7) Label (from memory) all states on a map of the United States. Include the capital cities of at least ten states (including California, New York, and Texas)
